We will be learning to: <u>Communication and</u> language (C&L)

<u>Personal, social and emotional</u> <u>development (PSED)</u>

- Share our own knowledge and understanding
- Attend to and take account of what others have said, asking appropriate questions of them.

Expressive Art and Design (EAD)

- Mix colours
- Use different approaches to fix things together
- Find ways to make our creations even better
- Use stories/ information that we have learnt, to

<u>How can you help?</u>

- Talk about how plants grow and possibly grow one together!
- Point out different plants you see around
- Talk about Lent and Easter
- Practise counting from 1-100 and back from 20-0.
- Look at real life examples of 3D shapes and discuss their properties, such as corners (Vertices), faces and edges.
- Practise reading and writing the 100 HFW that are in your child's reading record.
- Read some traditional tales and ask your child to retell the story.
- Play free educational games online (google phonicsplay and topmarks)
- Practise using scissors at home.
- Look on Pinterest for fine motor activities. These will help your child to hold and control their pencil e.g. using playdough, using tweezers
- Read with your child every night. Don't forget the HFW in their envelope!
