SNOW & BAD WEATHER POLICY

In the event of bad weather it is always the school's priority to open and as such, the school team will work to ensure that the school is accessible and safe.

There are however rare instances where the school might not be able to open as normal as a result of severe weather and in such an instance closing/opening arrangements will be communicated to parents/carers on the school website and by group text messaging and also via Radio (Key 103).

A nominated member of staff will send group text messages and notify the radio station. The person responsible for the school website will ensure a message is placed on the site for parents/carers to access.

Where no updates have been provided, parents should assume that the school is open as normal.

In the event of bad weather the school advises all pupils, staff and visitors to wrap up warmly and wear sensible shoes.
