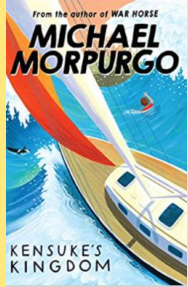


# Y6 Curriculum Newsletter - Autumn Term

## Literacy



This term, the children will be reading 'Kensuke's Kingdom' as their class novels. They will also be reading a selection of Michael Morpurgo's short stories as part of their guided reading sessions. Their writing will include a diary entry, a non-chronological report, a newspaper report and an explanation text. Children should continue to read each night.

## Maths

In math's this term, the children will focus on place value (up to and beyond 5 digits), addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, statistics, shape and measurement (length, perimeter and area).

## Science

Our first topic is **light**. The children will investigate how light travels, different light sources and shadows.

After half term, we will study the topic **electricity**. This will include creating, drawing and investigating circuits.

## Home Learning

Reading is required still at home. Times tables should also be practiced if not secure up to 12 x 12.

## RE

This term's RE topics are loving, vocation and commitment and 'expectation' linked to Advent and Christmas.

## ICT

Children will be learning about E-safety and A.I

## Art

This term's artwork will be linked to our Geography topic, looking at Japanese artwork.

## Geography

In Autumn we will be studying the Japanese Tsunami of 2011. Children will further develop their use of map and atlases, as well as using the eight points of a compass and four and six figure grid references.
