Literacy

MICHAEL MORPURGO

This term, the children will be reading 'Kensuke's Kingdom' as their class novels. They will also be reading a selection of Michael Morpurgo's short stories as part of their guided reading sessions. Their writing will include a diary entry, a non-chronological report, a newspaper report and an explanation text. Children should continue to read each night.

Maths

In math's this term, the children will focus on place value (up to and beyond 5 digits), addition and subtraction, multiplication and division. statistics, shape and measurement (length, perimeter and area).

Science

Our first topic is light. The children will investigate how light travels, different light sources and shadows.

After half term, we will study the topic electricity. This will include creating, drawing and investigating circuits.

Home Learning

Reading is required still at home. Times tables should also be practiced if not secure up to $12 \times$

Children will be learning about E-safety and A.I
