Year Two Spring 2025

Literacy

This term we will begin by studying 'The Tempest' by William Shakespeare. The children will be taking parts of lots of drama, writing their own magic spells, writing a setting description and also a letter. Children will continue to develop their reading and comprehension skills throughout. We will read non-fiction texts linked to the various topics we are exploring. We will continue our GPS focusing on nouns, adjectives and commas. Spelling and handwriting will be a key focus throughout the year. Children will also continue to progress through the SoundsWrite phonics programme

Maths

We will begin with developing our understanding of money, working with pence and notes. This will include working out how much change would be given if buying an item.

We will then move onto multiplication and division focusing on 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's. Lots of opportunities for problem solving based around this will be covered.

Lastly, we will cover measurement this term which will include length, height, mass, capacity and temperature. We will be using relevant mathematical units of measurement throughout this topic including centimetres, metres, grams and kilograms.

Science

We will be learning animals and humans, including their habitats. Next half term, we will be learning about materials.
