

Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter - Summer 2024

Literacy

The children will be reading and writing linked to our class novel 'Leo and the Gorgon's Curse' by Joe Todd Stanton. Year 3 will be to using paragraphs, inverted commas for speech and using conjunctions to create longer sentences.

Maths

We will be learning about fractions and time. In fractions we are comparing and ordering fractions then adding and subtracting them. In time we will be learning how to tell the time to the minute, using am and pm then looking at the 24 hour clock.

We will be working hard to develop swift recall of our 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. We have a test every Friday.

Science

Our focus in the spring term is plants. We start by looking at the parts of plants then what they need to survive. Then we move onto light and how it travels.

Art/Dt

We will be using collage and line drawing skills linked to Ancient Greece.
