Literacy - Shakespeare!

We will begin looking at Shakespeare. The Tempest - focusing on descriptive writing and expressing emotions through acting and writing in role.

The children will be reading and acting out parts of our historical novel - The Magic and the Mummy by Terry Dreary. We are really focusing on our writing and editing skills.

Maths

We will be consolidating our 2, 4 and 8 times tables, as well as using grid method to multiply a 2 digit number (and divide). We will work on measurement (money, length and perimeter) and consolidate our knowledge of fractions from year 2.

We need rapid recall of multiplication facts for weekly times table tests.

Science

Our focus will be Movement, Forces and Magnets all term. We will be carrying out lots of different experiments.

Music

We will be composing this term and creating a storm in our work on The Tempest.
