Headteacher's Update

I hope everyone found our recent Progress Review Day helpful. Due to COVID and the restrictions that has placed on bringing people into schools we decided to try and be more creative with our communication with parents. Hopefully, Progress Review Day was an opportunity for you as parents to get to know one of the most important people in your child's school day – their form tutor.

It was also an opportunity to discuss significant matters which are all crucial to your child's education. There was a heavy emphasis on discussing key points such as attendance, punctuality, behaviour, attitude to learning and the overall progress picture. These things can't be discussed with individual subject teachers. There was also the identification of targets for improvement overall. In terms of improving within subject areas we have classcharts to converse with individual staff and subject teachers provide feedback in books for pupils to make subject specific improvements.

Form Tutors will continue to play a significant part in monitoring your son / daughter's progress. We hope that now you have had an opportunity to meet them and begin a dialogue and a relationship that this will continue and flourish. This will hopefully help to ensure your child is safe, happy and successful at St Cuthbert's.

We continue our return to a normal school experience. From next week we will be returning to real life assemblies. These are an aspect of school we have sorely missed. There are always key messages to give out and these can be done much more effectively in real life than over a computer screen. We will keep you informed of any further developments of this nature as and when we introduce them.

At present however, can I please ask that everyone still follows the current guidance on the matters surrounding testing twice per week and staying at home if symptoms develop. Whilst we still have isolation periods in place we need to make sure as few people as possible are affected. Students who are isolating can of course access their lessons remotely.
