Tier 1 C3 Detention (KS3) Tier 1 C3 Detention (KS4)	Cuisine REFLECT	<p style="text-align: center;">Mon-Fri, 14.50-15.20</p> Students will make their own way to the Cuisine / REFLECT, where they will sit their half-an-hour detention.	If a student fails to attend a detention / refuses attendance / fails their detention, they will be collected the next day at 2.15pm, taken to their detention room and expected to complete their detention until 3.50pm. This will be communicated home after non-attendance on the previous day by parental/carer phone call.
Tier 1 C4 Detention (KS3) Tier 1 C4 Detention (KS4)	Cuisine REFLECT	<p style="text-align: center;">Mon-Fri, 14.50-15.50</p> Students will be collected between 14.30 and 14.50 and taken to the Cuisine / REFLECT, where they will sit their one-hour detention.	
Tier 2 KS3 Detention Tier 2 KS4 Detention	Cuisine REFLECT	<p style="text-align: center;">Mon-Fri, 14.15-15.50</p> Students will be collected between 14.15 and 14.30 and taken to the Cuisine / REFLECT, where they will sit their one-hour detention.	If a student fails to complete a Tier 2 detention or fails two detentions in a row (for whatever reason), they will be collected at 12.10pm the next day and work in isolation in room 406 until 3.50pm with a cold lunch option only.
Tier 3 Detention	406	<p style="text-align: center;">Mon-Fri, 12.15-15.50</p> Students will be collected from their P4 lesson and taken to 406, where they will order and eat a cold lunch. Whilst in 406, students will remote-in to their timetable lessons or complete work	If a student fails to complete this Tier 3 detention, they will then be placed in REFLECT for the duration of the next school day and/or be allocated a place at another school.
