Dear Parent / Carer

I hope this finds you and your family well. I write with some reminders for the new academic year.

Today we were delighted to welcome our Year 7 and Year 11 students to school for their induction day. Tomorrow (Friday 4<sup>th</sup> September), we will welcome our Year 8, 9 and 10 students back for their induction day and we very much look forward to **all students** returning to school on **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> September**.

To assist with a smooth return to school, it is important that the information in the Headteacher's most recent communication (1<sup>st</sup> September) is read with your child.

In addition to that I would like to highlight the following:

- Face masks *must* be worn when students are moving around school, in corridors and other indoor communal areas. It is essential that these fit students properly.
- A healthy snack should be brought for break time as we are currently unable to provide food at breakfast or break.
- Students should bring a filled water bottle each day.
- We are now a cashless school and therefore dinner money can only be topped up via ParentPay and PayPoints. Please contact the school for user details to set this account up and ensure the account is credited to allow students to purchase food at lunchtime.
- It is essential that students do not attend school if they or anyone in their household displays any symptoms of COVID-19. If symptoms do develop, it is essential that all members of the household isolate and are tested. If your child or anyone in the household has a positive test result then they must isolate for 14 days.
- A reminder of the timings of the school day for each yeargroup is also attached.

Finally, we ask all parents and carers to be mindful of the safety of students and staff on duty when they drop off or collect their child from school. There is very limited parking outside school and to ensure the safety of all, cars are not permitted to park directly outside the school gates. This area will have cones so it is easily identifiable. We thank you in advance for your co-operation with this.
