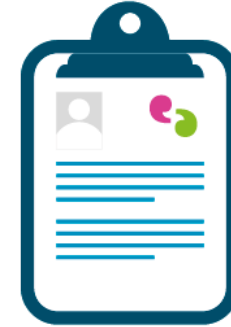
The following Terms and Conditions apply:
