Re: Year 11 Results Day

Year 11 results day will be held in school on Thursday 12th August. Students will be invited into school at the times below to collect their results.


11.1 & 11.2 – 9.00 – 9.20 am
11.3 & 11.4 - 9.20 – 9.40 am
11.5 & 11.6 – 9.40 – 10.00am
11.7 & 11.8 – 10.00 – 10.20am

Students should come into school through the main entrance and make their way to the school hall where they will be given their results. Students will then be asked to complete a short questionnaire regarding their intended destination post 16 before leaving site. It would be really helpful if students have access to their school email on their phones to complete this, but if this is not possible, there will be laptops available to complete this on. Any results which have not been collected during these sessions will be posted home at the end of the day. If your child is unable to attend this session, they can ask someone to collect their results, but they must bring a letter which is signed by your child giving permission for collection from the named person and identification to prove who they are. If your child is not attending results day in person, please ask them to complete the questionnaire which will be emailed to their school email once they have received their results as this will allow us to prioritise which students we need to make further contact with to support them with their next steps.

At 11am, the results will also be emailed out to all students along with detailed information regarding the individual assessment details which were used to determine the teacher assessed grade. These results will also be then available to upload to any colleges who are requesting grades to be submitted electronically.

On the day, there will be support for students from our teaching staff, Paul Ferry (our careers advisor), Hopwood Hall and Rochdale Sixth Form College should your child have any questions or need to make any further applications to college. We will also have a scanner available for students to upload their results if necessary, as we know some colleges are asking for results to be scanned and emailed to them.

The teacher assessed grades (TAGS) that have been determined by the teachers at St Cuthbert's have undergone a 3 step quality assurance process by the JCQ and examination boards. Our policy, procedures and grades passed this quality assurance at each stage. Your child however still has the right to appeal their grade. The flow chart below summarises the process.



Details of how your child can make an appeal will be shared with them on results day and Mrs Hill will be available to answer any questions regarding this process that they may have. The appeals window opens on Monday 16th August 2021 and closes on Monday 3rd September 2021.

There is also an opportunity for your child to sit an actual GCSE examination paper in November if they would like the opportunity to improve their TAG. Again details of how to request this opportunity will be shared on results day.

If your child has purchased a leavers hoody, this will be available for collection from the school hall whilst GCSE results are being collected.

Finally, if your child has any school uniform, PE kit or revision guides which are no longer any use to them, we would be really grateful for any donations.

We would request students wear masks whilst inside and try to keep as socially distanced as possible whilst collecting their results to try and keep everyone safe.
