Good Hand Hygiene

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we enter a season where respiratory and stomach illnesses can be more common, we want to remind everyone about the importance of good hand-hygiene to help keep our school community healthy. Effective handwashing is one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of infections.

Please follow these guidelines:

- Wash hands properly: Ensure children wash their hands thoroughly with warm water and liquid soap at these key times:
 - After using the toilet
 - Before eating or preparing food
 - After playtime
 - After sneezing, coughing, or blowing their nose

- **Use the right supplies:** Schools provide liquid soap for handwashing. Please ensure your child uses these facilities. Drying hands is an essential part of the process.
- When to stay home: To help prevent spreading germs, please do not send your child to school if they are experiencing vomiting or diarrhoea. They should stay home until 48 hours after their <u>last episode</u> of illness.
- When in doubt: If you have any questions about whether your child is well enough to attend school, please consult your doctor or the school nurse.
