Dear Parent/Carer,

All children in Key Stage 2 are expected to have their PE kit in school every day from Monday 8th September.

School PE Kit consists of

- Suitable outdoor trainers
- Plain black shorts and white T-shirt
- Grey, black or dark blue tracksuit (to be as plain as possible, no large brand logos, writing or patterns) to be worn on top of t-shirt and shorts in cold weather
- PE socks

All items must be clearly labelled with the child's full name.

PE lessons will take place both inside and outside. Lessons may still happen in light rain, when the ground is wet and in cold weather. It is therefore essential that children have a complete PE kit so they can have both enjoyable and productive lessons. We strongly encourage that PE kits are left in school and not taken home each week to wash. The class teacher will send PE kits home if they require washing. Children who do not have their PE kits in school may not be able to take part in PE lessons.

Earrings

- We discourage pupils from wearing earrings to school as they are very unsafe for PE and games.
- If worn, only studs or sleepers should be used.
- Pupils are expected to remove their own earrings (if worn) when doing PE.

Jewellery

- Pupils should not wear jewellery to school, unless required by religious doctrine.

PE kits should only be brought home at the end of each half term to be washed. In certain circumstances, the class teacher may send the PE kit home to be washed. However, it must be returned to school by the following Monday.
