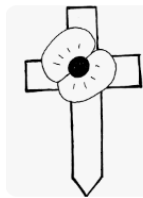

**SHARING SUNDAY'S GOSPEL
WITH PARENTS & FAMILIES**

When some were talking about the Temple, remarking how it was adorned with fine stonework and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All these things you are staring at now, the time will come when not a single stone will be left on another; they will all have been knocked down. And they put to him this question: "Master, when will this happen then and what sign will there be that this is about to take place?" "Take care not to be deceived," He said "because many will come using my name and saying, 'I am here.'" Refuse to join them." Then he said to them "When you hear of wars and revolutions, do not be frightened. There will be wars, earthquakes, plagues and famines here and there; there will be great signs in the heavens.
