Preparation for Year 3

Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to meet your children last week and we hope they enjoyed spending some time in their new classrooms with their new Teachers and Teaching Assistants.

As your child begins Year 3 in the next academic year, they will be joining the Junior School. This exciting transition into Key Stage 2 means there are changes to the uniform, equipment and collection/drop off point.

Uniform:

- White shirts, a red fleece or jumper with grey school trousers/skirt
- Ties (available to purchase at the school office)
- Black shoes or plain black trainers with no logo/white soles
- PE kits - white t shirt with black shorts or grey/black jogging bottoms during Winter and trainers.

Equipment:

Although each class is provided with some stationary we kindly ask each child to please bring in their own in a small pencil case (as this will need to fit into an under desk tray). Each child will need the following items: HB pencils to write with, 30 cm ruler, rubber, sharpener, colouring pencils and a glue stick. We strongly advise that pencil cases and equipment are named where possible.

Collection/drop off:

The Year 3 classes use their own gate on Roe Way where children can be dropped off and collected. Be advised that there are driving and parking restrictions on this road at certain times of the day. School hours remain the same. Please inform the teacher if you need to make other arrangements regarding siblings from other year groups.

We will be holding a curriculum meeting at the beginning of the Autumn term where we will give you further information about the curriculum, any changes in homework requirements and we will be happy to answer any questions you might have.

We are really looking forward to the upcoming school year with your children and thank you for the continued support. If you have any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to ask.
