
75% 5A*-C including English and Maths - an increase of 8%

We are delighted that our Year 11 pupils have achieved and exceeded all expectations. 75% of Year 11 achieved the Government measure of 5A*-C including English and Maths-a fantastic increase of 9% from the 2012 results. The 5 A*-C pass rate was also St Gabriel's highest ever at 91%. We are particularly pleased that over 40% of these achieved 5 A*-B grades and 23 pupils achieved 9 or more A* or A grades. This is the first stage in the drive to achieve our vision of 'world class Catholic education'.

Building on the very best traditions of this outstanding Catholic school I am delighted that the hard work and perseverance of our young people has come to fruition. By developing further our teaching and learning, and supported by our creative and innovative thinking, our committed staff have again put the children at the centre of everything we do. £300,000 Refurbishment

It's been another very busy summer holidays for the school. Whilst everyone has been on their holidays, contractors have come into school to improve our facilities in a big way. Eight classrooms have been completely refurbished with new suspended ceilings, new heating system, new carpets and redecorated. Some rooms have also had new interactive whiteboards installed. These are RE, Humanities and Maths rooms. We have also carpeted two English rooms in the Paul Hopkins Building and re-floored Lab H in the John Banks Building.

All the corridors have been re-floored and the main corridor of the school redecorated along with a new suspended ceiling. A new fire alarm system has been installed, which also links to the class-change 'bell'.

In order to improve safeguarding, we have created a new lobby entrance for visitors and replaced some of the outside wooden doors with new, modern and safe aluminium framed doors.

A new car park will be created at the front of the school before the end of September for visitors and staff, and there will be some further changes to the school gates to ensure that our safeguarding is robust.

The governors of the school are committed to ensuring that our learning environment continues to develop and enhance the learning experience of our children. Having just achieved our best ever results in the history of the school, we continue to go from strength to strength. We are very grateful to Mr John Baxter our project manager for overseeing this major development and to HH Smith and Son Builders for completing the work in a very short period of time.
