Parent Procedure

Support pupils learning environment:

- Provide a designated space (away from devices/distractions).
- Provide notebooks/paper and equipment to supplement their on line learning.
- Encourage routines (realistic wake up and bedtimes, set meal times).
- Encourage children to stay hydrated throughout the day.
- Encourage healthy and nutritious snacks/meals.

Support pupils learning activities:

- Review timetable expectations with your child.
- Where possible, encourage children to access their lessons at the correct time according to their timetable.
- Ask them to show you how to log into Google classroom.
- Read through Google classroom instructions with your child, and review the lesson content.
- Watch pre-recorded videos with your child.
- Once work is complete, review the work with your child.
- Ensure the work is submitted via the 'turn in' or 'hand in' button in the Google classroom.

Support pupils completing learning activities

Once a week, a text message will be sent to parents/carers identifying if any work has not been submitted. Please discuss this with your child if you receive a message and reinforce the importance of engaging with the online lessons.

We appreciate you may not be able to supervise your children throughout the day, and may have your own work demands and other pressures during this time. These suggestions are intended to be supportive, and ways that we can help work together to best support the progress of our young people.
