CHANGES TO NATIONAL FRAMEWORK

First penalty: From August 2024, the fine for school absences across the country will be £80 if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days. This will be issued to each parent for each child.

Second penalty: In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second fine for the same child within any three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of £160 with no reduction for early payment. Again this will be issued to each parent for each child.

Further penalties: Fines per parent will be capped to two fines within any three-year period. Once this limit has been reached, other action like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered. If you're prosecuted and attend court because your child hasn't been attending school, you could get a fine of up to £2,500.

Additionally Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period.
