Uniform Information

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you today to provide an important reminder about St George's School's uniform policy. As we approach the new academic year, we want to ensure all pupils are prepared and adhere to our standards, which contribute to a positive and focused learning environment. Full details of our uniform policy can always be found on our school website

We would like to draw your attention to the following key areas:

Appearance and Accessories:

- Makeup: Only natural, minimal makeup is permitted. This means no false eyelashes, no fake tan, no foundation, no eyeliner or eyeshadow, no nail varnish, and no false nails are allowed.
- **Jewellery:** No jewellery of any kind is permitted, with the exception of a watch (which must not be a smart watch). Piercings are not allowed.

Mobile Phones and Smartwatches:

- Mobile phones and smartwatches must be switched off and kept in bags at all times during the school day.
- If a mobile phone or smartwatch is visible or audible at any point, it will be confiscated for a full term. Emergency contact with any pupil can always be made via the academy office.

School Uniform - General:

 The standard school uniform can be purchased from First Class Kids. Blazers, ties, the branded school skirt or the plain black school trousers are compulsory. Jumpers are optional.







- School Skirts: We have a strict policy regarding school skirts. There are only two standard skirt lengths available from our supplier, First Class Kids, and skirts must be to the knee. We are aware that some parents have chosen to have skirts altered in length, making them considerably shorter than our specified length. In September, we will be checking the length of all skirts. If a skirt is found to be shorter than the standard length sold at First Class Kids and is deemed to have been altered, pupils will be issued a new skirt from our school stock, and parents will be charged via ParentPay. Alternatively, girls may wear plain black tailored trousers. Please note that while waistbands can be altered for size, the length of the skirt must not be changed.
- Shoes: Shoes must be plain black and made of leather or a leather-type material. Sports brands such as Nike or Adidas, visible logos, bubble soles, or ballet pumps are not permitted. We strongly encourage parents to check our website for pictures of acceptable and unacceptable shoes before purchasing to avoid any unnecessary issues.

School Bags:

- For new Year 7 pupils and those entering Year 8 in September 2025, school bags must be the standard St George's bag, available from First Class Kids.
- For all other pupils (Year 9 and above), bags must be a rucksack.

Physical Education (PE) Kit:

- Full PE kits must be brought into school on the day your child has PE. This includes training shoes and PE socks.
- If a child is injured and unable to participate actively in PE, they must still bring their full PE kit to school as they will be given an appropriate, alternative role within the lesson.

We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that all pupils adhere to these rules. A consistent approach to uniform and appearance helps to maintain the high standards and respectful environment we strive for at St George's School.
