#### Changes to School Uniform - September 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to remind you of the changes to our academy uniform. Our new uniform will be in place from September 2024. Students starting Y7 in September will follow the full new uniform list in the table below.

The new academy bag is also a compulsory part of the year 7 uniform, and will also be available for other year groups to purchase at First Class Kids. The school bag is a large, navy backpack and this is the only bag permitted for students. Please ensure that your child's bag is clearly named on the label included. We ask that PE kit bags are dark in colour.

For other year groups, the old uniform can still be worn until your child grows out of it. However, the new uniform can also be purchased and worn if this is your preference. We will not punish anyone who does not have the new uniform, as we have taken a gradual rollout approach to ease any financial burden. Instead, when you find it necessary to replace uniform items, please ensure that you purchase items from the new stock. We are aware that this may mean that students have mis-matched uniform items for a period of time.

Previously, year groups wore different coloured ties per year group - the new uniform will be the same tie for all years. Similarly, Year 11 previously had a different blazer to the rest of the school - this will no longer be the case. All pupils will wear the same navy uniform once fully rolled out. From parental feedback, pupils only had nine months of wear from the year 11 blazer and again this does not equate to value for money. In future years, this may mean a pupil will only need one blazer in Key Stage 4- depending on how fast they grow!

Finally, following pupil feedback we have introduced an optional jumper. If purchased this is to be worn with the blazer and not instead of.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The P.E. kit is an essential part of the school uniform and will be required from the beginning of the school year.

Parents should always consult this list or school BEFORE purchasing any item so that costly and unacceptable mistakes can be avoided. Pupils may be required to return home if improperly dressed or equipped or if deemed to be unsafe. Any item purchased in contravention of the uniform code will not be permitted and parents/carers will be required to change it for the correct item.

- All clothing, both PE kit and school uniform, <u>must</u> be clearly labelled with the pupil's name - name tapes or stickers are advised, or laundry markers can be used on labels. Any unmarked clothing left behind after PE lessons will be returned to the owner if clearly labelled. If we are unable to identify who it belongs to, it will become lost property.
- 2. Pupils are expected to bring their kit for every PE lesson. Parents will be notified if a pupil arrives to a lesson ill-equipped on more than a single occasion in any half-term. This will also result in a sanction for the pupil.
