Homework - Year 7, 8 & 9

- Pupils are provided with a large plastic wallet, purple pen, ruler, Knowledge Organiser, Maths Drill booklet and Literacy booklet at start of each Progress Period.
- Pupils complete homework every school night;
 - 30 minutes on Knowledge Organisers
 - o 20 minutes on Maths
 - o 20 minutes on Reading
 - o 10 minutes on Spelling
 - o 1 hour 20 each day.
- Pupils learn spellings each week (these are blocked into word groups with other similar spellings, suffixes, prefixes etc)
- Pupils complete weekly Knowledge Organiser Quiz and a weekly Spelling Test (scores collated on SIMS by form tutors).
- Pupils complete Maths booklet once a week at home
- Pupils complete Literacy booklet during Morning Meeting with common literacy misconceptions
- Application Tasks made available weekly for HAP and optional for others
- Enterprise stretch project available to further develop pupils' inquisitiveness to learn coming soon

Knowledge Organiser Activities Monday - Friday

- Core subjects, humanities and MFL only.
- KOs checked for appropriate, streamlined knowledge that strongly supports the curriculum and is fully built into and used in the delivery of the curriculum.
- Homework style set by Morning Lead (i.e. design a gap fill, write 5 questions, write a song, look check cover). This is to stop simply copying from KOs and completing a week's worth of homework in one sitting. This should use approximately half an A4 page.
- In addition, pupils complete self quizzing lines. Pupils complete a further half a page writing out the key information from memory and self-checking using purple pens.
- Checked in Morning Meeting by form tutor and central detention set for that day for non-completion.

- Application tasks additional application tasks set weekly for pupils to complete (optional at this stage although HAP pupils will be guided to complete).
- Celebration breakfast (eg) for Top Scorers every 7 weeks and outstanding effort in KO homeworks.
- Monitored by Maths teacher central detention set for that day if not completed.

Spellings

- Pupils given groups of words to learn each week. 10 words will be words selected from word groups (i.e. 'tion', 'ic' 'ible').
- Pupils expected to learn 5 words per night and produce on their A4 piece of homework, proof of self-quizzing and revision.
- Pupils are tested on 10 of the 25 words during weekly spelling test.
- Form tutors record scores on SIMS (separate to KO quiz)

Year 9

- Year 9 follow a separate model to acknowledge the fact students are studying options.
- Year 9 complete maths homework every evening
- Year 9 also have Exam Booklet for completion of exam style questions.
