



- Bucket toss - Label some buckets or tubs with numbers (these can be small or big based on your confidence with numbers). Throw 3 to 5 pairs of balled up socks into the tubs. Can you find the total?
Variations: Multiply the numbers, aim for a target number over a few goes (how many more do you need?)
