English tasks

Our learning focus:

To draw inferences such as; inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions & justifying inferences with evidence

Identifying main ideas drawn from more than 1 paragraph and summarising these

Make sensible predictions using evidence from the text

Read aloud to an audience

Activities you could complete:

1. Listen to me read or read chapter 13 - Slugs and Superheroes. Tomas seems to be having some issues with Liam - who seems to target him with unkind words and means actions. I think it is about time we gave Tomas some advice of what to do; **we're going to become agony aunts**. An agony aunts give good, practical advice to people who need it. Read the letter from Tomas to the agony aunt. Send a reply letter. Your letter will need to include;
Address, date and who it is to;
an opening paragraph (thanking Tomas for the letter, reassuring Tomas that Liam should not behaving like this towards him, saying you understand his problem and would like to help)
A second paragraph with the advice of what Tomas could do;
A closing paragraph reassuring Tomas to seek help, follow your advice and that he can write again if the problem does not stop.
2. Listen to me read or read chapter 14 - Crispy Cornflake and Crumb-Fest. Answer the following questions:

Maths tasks

Our learning focus: Measurement

To measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml)

Activities you could complete:

- 1) Watch the video clip showing how to read scales correctly, in millilitres and litres.

- 3) Reading scales: Practise reading scales in litres and millilitres for the volume of liquids (see the website below*).
- 4) Problem solving - Potions capacity: Wizard William and Witch Winifred are mixing potions. Can you help find all the possibilities for their recipes?
- 5) List, or take photos of different items which can be used to measure. Record which unit of measurement is used for each item. I found 4 in my house! Can you beat the teacher!?
- 6) Colour the measuring jugs so they hold the correct amount of liquid shown
- 7) Continue to practice your multiplication and division on Times Tables Rockstars.

- 1) Apart from Flicker who else has made a mess in the kitchen?
- 2) What foods was mum sweeping up?
- 3) Where did Tomas pin the picture?
- 4) Where would the astronaut have landed if mum had not have caught it?
- 5) On arrival what did his nan give him to take down to grandad?
- 6) Name two types of beans Grandad could have planted?
- 7) What animal does grandad think is eating the fruit?

3. Listen to me read or read chapter 15 - Bingo! Up until page 117. Can you read page 118 - once again practice and make sure you can pronounce any tricky words - film yourself read the page and up-load to Seesaw.

4. Listen to me read or read chapter 16 - Bat Watch! A bat hunt sounds like lots of fun - time for you to go on an animal hunt - this could be a bug hunt in the garden, a dog hunt on a walk (what different breeds can you see?) or an animal hunt on-line (watch a video about the jungle or African plains). Complete the attached sheet.
