Our learning focus:

To give descriptions, explanations and narratives for different purposes, including for expressing feelings

Activities you could complete:

4. Complete the VE Day vocabulary sheet - look at the pictures and add verbs, adjectives and emotions to the table to describe the scene.
5. Complete the 'What people are saying task'. Look at the picture on the sheet and from what you have learnt about VE Day write down what a child and adult might be thinking and saying about VE Day.

Adding and subtracting money

Activities you could complete:

- 1) Using a till receipt, add together any two prices using column addition. Challenge yourself by adding more items together or using higher priced items!
- 2) Complete a worksheet - Adding and subtracting money
- 3) Create a shop where everything costs less than £1.00. Ask someone at home to buy some of your items (no more than 5). Can you add up what they have spent? If they paid with a £5 pound note how much change would they get? (Use column subtraction or a number line to help you).
