We will continue to focus on our own mental health and wellbeing, as well as how to support each other. From this, we will have lots of discussion around our feelings and how to deal with feelings or worry.



English

We will be reading and writing different myths this half term, and finding out the origins of these stories. After half term we will move onto non-fiction writing and discover a range of biographies. We will continue to learn new sentence types and punctuation that will support with this, as well as further developing our vocabulary. We will then progress on to balanced arguments.

For reading, we will continue to carry out regular whole class reading as well as progressing on Reading Plus. It is important that children also access this at home.

Science

We begin this term learning about materials and their properties. We are looking forward to finding out which mixtures can be separated, what happens when things dissolve and what the difference is between a reversible and irreversible change...

We will then move on to Sound, within which we will learn about sound waves, calculating the speed of sound and the range of frequencies that humans and animals can hear.

In music we will continue working with Miss York from TVMS. We will continue learning how to




Our PE lessons for Spring will begin with Dance. We will then be attending swimming lessons where we will learn different Swimming techniques and water safety.

We will also be covering measurement including area and perimeter. After this, we will be returning to the topic of fractions, where again it is extremely important to be secure with all times tables facts.
