RSE

Autumn Term 2022

We are all created and loved by God. Children will explore this topic during RSE this term.

English

During this term, we will begin reading the book 'Escape to Pompeii' as a basis for our lessons and will use this, as a focus for our writing.

We will also be recapping some of the writing elements from Year 3, such as; punctuation and using different sentence types. We will apply these skills in a range of different genres including descriptive and narrative writing.

We will continue to practise our handwriting, in order to ensure a fluent, joined writing style.

Science

In our first science topic, we will be learning about Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn how to use classification keys to help group and identify a variety of living things. We will also find out how environments can change and how this can sometimes pose dangers to living things.

Our second topic this term will be Animals (including humans). Here we will learn about our digestive system and the functions of teeth, before finally finishing exploring food chains.

The Arts

This term we will be enjoying an Art Day and a DT Day to focus our learning. We will be base our art on the story 'The Dot'. The children will be challenged to explore a range of drawing materials to create art using dots as their starting points. In November, we will be using our DT skills in order to help some well-loved story characters solve a range of problems.

In music, we will focus initially on the work of ABBA in our unit Mamma Mia. We will listen to and appraise songs, play instruments, compose and perform our creations. In Y4, we have also introduced a 'Song of the Day' where the children are exposed to different genres of music and artists.

Maths

We will start this term learning about place value. This includes understanding 4 digit numbers, rounding to the nearest 10 and 100 and comparing numbers, before progressing onto addition and subtraction involving 4 digit numbers. We will also consolidate our knowledge of the

2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables, before moving on to learning the 6 times tables. Please practise these at home as much as possible!

History / Geography



Angry Earth is our first Geography topic. We will be finding out about the structure of the earth, leading into volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunamis. Our History unit, Ancient Greece, will commence after half term. We will learn about who the Ancient Greeks were, the different Greek gods, the story of the Trojan horse and how democracy began.

PE

This term we will be taking a close look at invasion games, learning about the skills and tactics involved in football before putting these skills into games situations. PE is on a Tuesday so please come in your kit on this day.





We will be starting our topic with some basic greetings such as hello, goodbye and good morning. This will help us to have simple conversations with each other.
