

## Adding and Subtracting Money

- Choose a pair of items from the following list.
- Calculate the total cost mentally.
- Then use a counting up strategy to calculate the change from £10.
- Repeat this for another 3 pairs of items.



£3.60



£4.10



£2.50



£3.10



£1.90

£4.30



£5.20

- Now choose three items that will have a total cost of less than £10.
- Calculate the total cost and the change from £10.
- The shopkeeper decides to increase the cost of each item by 70p.
- Write the new cost of each item.
