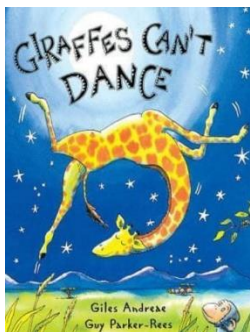


## Summer Term 2 Week 1 – 1.06.20

### Writing

### Knowledge & Understanding – Regrowing Experiment (Carrot)

- 1) Add a layer of cotton wool to a small container.
- 2) Add a little water to the cotton wool before placing a carrot top into the dish.
- 3) Leave the container in a sunny spot. The shoots should be visible in a few days.



### Maths

**Ordering numbers** - Write numbers 1 – 5, 10 or 20 on objects for children to order. Pieces of Lego would be perfect for this.

**Repeating patterns** – Ask someone at home to clap out a pattern for you to copy then repeat it back to them. Try this with some other body percussion, including tapping your knees, legs, shoulders and head.

**Shape** – Draw or paint a picture of your favourite place. This could be the park, beach or your house. What shapes can you see in your picture?
