- How can we help?

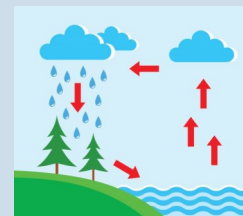
Some animals you could research are: bees, orang-utans, tigers, pandas, hammerhead sharks, water voles, great crested newts.
