## *Geography- Japanese Tsunami 2011*

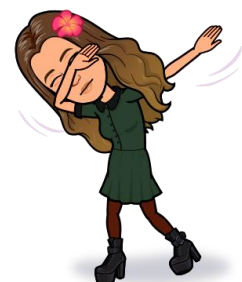
