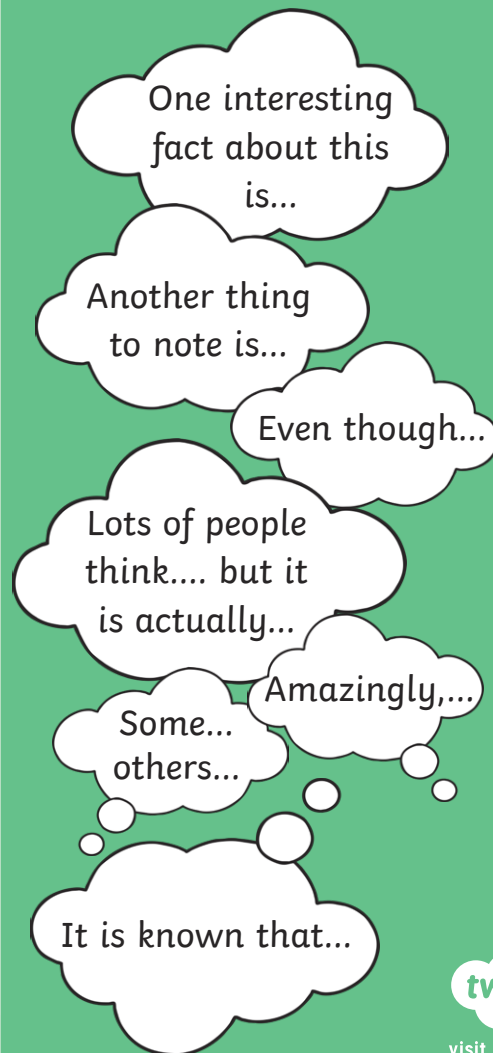


# Non-Chronological Report Writing Word Mat

## Features

- start with a big title at the top of the report;
- write an introduction to tell readers what the report will be about;
- put your information into sections;
- give each section a sub-heading;
- use facts that you have researched;
- include pictures with captions.

- One mammal that lives in the Arctic is the polar bear.

- The North Pole is actually covered in a very thick sheet of ice.



## Remember to...



- use capital letters for names, places and at the beginning of sentences;
- end your sentences with a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark;
- separate items in a list using commas;
- add an apostrophe to show possession, e.g. the fox's fur;
- use joining words to add extra information to your sentences;
- use spelling rules to spell words correctly
