

Ordering Numbers Game - Negative Numbers



Need: Game board, number cards (resources found on subsequent pages)

- Children work in pairs to fill the spaces on the game board.
- Children should identify the largest and smallest numbers in their set and also the step size.
- The number cards are turned face down and mixed up.
- One card is turned over and must be placed in one of the steps on the game board. Once the position of this number has been decided, it cannot be moved.
- Another number card is turned over and placed on the game board.
- This continues until all the spaces are filled, and the six number cards on the game board are in order from smallest to largest.
- If there is not a space to fit a number card that has been turned over, then this is placed in the bin.

Ordering Numbers Game - Negative Numbers



1. Turn all the cards over so you can't see the numbers.


2. Choose one card, turn it over and put it in a space on the grid.

3. Keep doing this until all the spaces are filled.

4. The numbers must be in order, and once placed cannot be moved. If a number does not fit, it goes in the bin.
