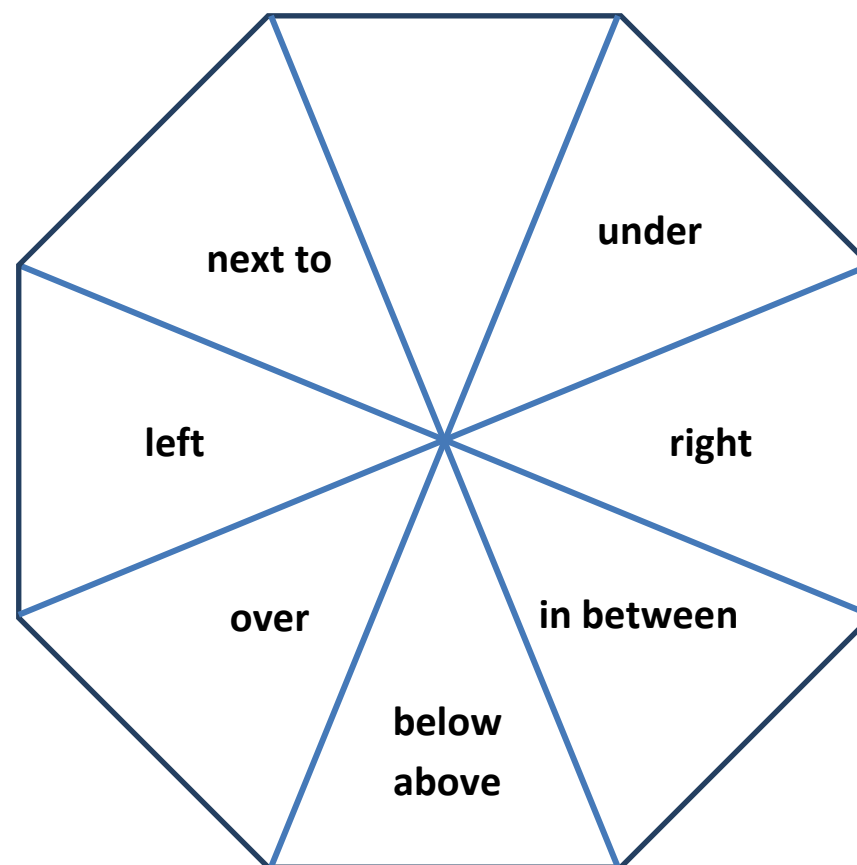
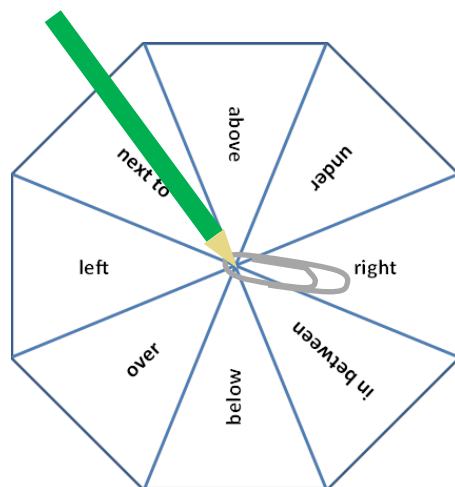




## Where Is..? Films

- The aim is for the children to accurately describe where a certain film is in the picture using specific vocabulary.
- The film cards are put in a pile face down.
- Each child in turn takes the top card from the pile and spins the paperclip spinner to reveal what word/phrase must be used.
  - For example, card is **Ice Age** and the word on the spinner is *left*.
  - The child needs to describe where the Ice Age film is and must use the word left – “Ice Age is on the left of Snow White”.
- Spinners can be made using this template and placing a paperclip on the centre point. A point of a pen or pencil is then put on the centre point (through the paperclip). This makes the paperclip the pointer of the spinner, so it can then be flicked around the spinner to generate the random positional word to be used.
