What can you make?

Next week's spellings are:

Adding suffixes after a 'y'

Suffixes include: s/es, ing, ed, er, est, ful, ment, ness, less

REMEMBER: Usually CHANGE IT: 'y' changes to 'i'.

If there is a vowel before the 'y', KEEP IT.
If you add the 'ing' suffix always KEEP the 'y'.

Consonant before 'y'	Words with a vowel before the 'y'
berry - berries	enjoy - enjoyed
puppy - puppies	destroy - destroying
library - libraries	annoy - annoyed
grumpy - grumpiest	stray - straying
sticky - stickiness	stay - stayed
funny - funnier	employ - employment
empty - emptiness	
carry - carried	
supply - supplying	
worry - worrying
