writing.

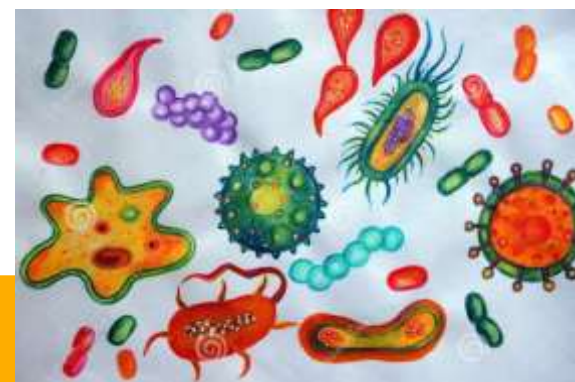
Next week in geography we will be learning
