This week discover flags from different countries around the world. You'll find a slideshow and worksheet to help you on our school website.

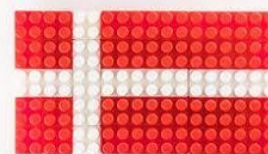
Remember to have fun exploring the countries on your map by using the Google Earth map.
