Maths

- Adding multiples of 10 to 2 digit numbers eg. $34 + 50 =$
- Subtracting multiples of 10 from 2 digit numbers eg. $73 - 40 =$
- Progress to adding and subtracting two 2 digit numbers, not crossing tens
- 2, 5 and 10 times tables- multiplication and division facts
- Telling the time using o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to

English

- Continue to read daily using your reading book and books from home, recording what you read in your reading record.
- Put your spellings in to sentences each week using capital letters and full stops.
- Choose a story you have enjoyed reading. Write the story thinking carefully about punctuation and spelling.

RE

Find out about the events of Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Choose two of these stories to retell.

- **Topic-** Find out what happened during the Great Fire of London. How and where did it start? How long did it last? How and where did it spread?
Record what happened using pictures and sentences.
- **PE-** Try to complete 30 minutes of exercise a day.
- **Science-** Think about the different materials we have looked at- glass, plastic, wood, fabric, metal, paper etc. Using objects around your house explore whether objects and materials can be bent, squashed, twisted and stretched.
- **Art/ DT-** Create a model of something from London past or present (1666). For example, a house from 1666, Big Ben, a fire engine, the London Eye.
