English

Spelling/ grammar work- This week's spellings are words ending with -tion.

Your word list is: action, station, motion, fiction, nation, national, section, position, solution, operation.

Reading

Please complete the reading comprehension 'The Wind and the Sun'. On the document you will see it is called an assessment, however, it does not have to be completed as an assessment, it can be done through reading aloud/ discussion etc.

Writing Task

Stories in imaginary/ fantasy settings- Use the PowerPoint and fantasy settings poster to think about stories in fantasy settings. What makes them imaginary? Why could they not be real? Can you think of any other fantasy stories you have read?

Choose one of the 'Treasures in the Garden' settings to write about. You need to describe the setting in full sentences using capital letters and full stops. Remember to use adjectives to describe. Think about what you can see (setting and character- you could give the characters names), what you might hear, what could you touch etc. This will help you with next week's task!

Art- Pablo Picasso

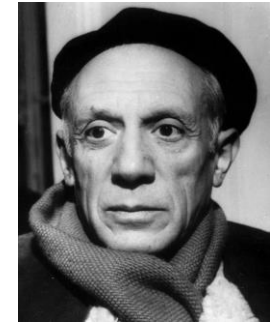
Use the PowerPoint (or carry out your own research) to find out about the artist Pablo Picasso.

Maths

This week we will be reminding ourselves what we learnt about addition and subtraction and using this to solve problems.

Key learning ideas:

- Add and subtract two single digit numbers
- Add and subtract a single digit to/from a 2 digit number
- Add and subtract multiples of 10 to/from a 2 digit number
- Add and subtract two 2 digit numbers

Remind yourself how to add and subtract. Use the addition and subtraction workbook to practise these skills. There are additional problems on the Maths challenge cards if you would like to try something a bit harder/ challenge yourself!
