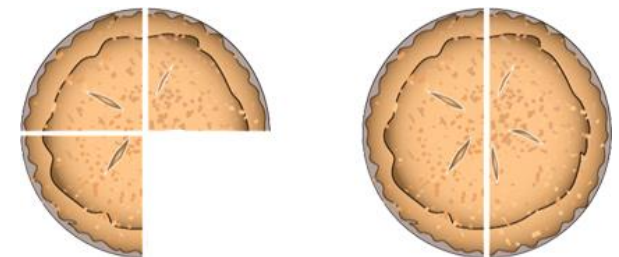
If you are unable to access these, using numbers and images please explore the concepts of:

Please also continue recapping/ learning times tables, addition, subtraction and time.

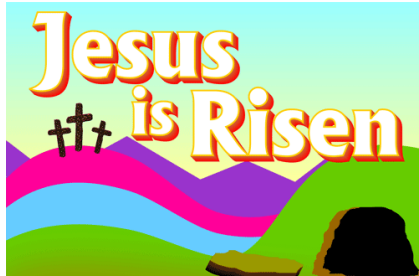
RE

How many flowers and trees can you name?



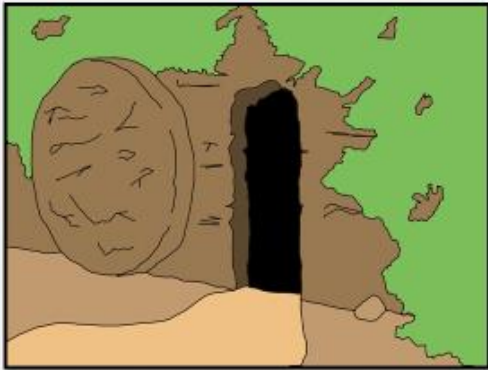
Can you name the parts of the trees and flowers?
