## Maths

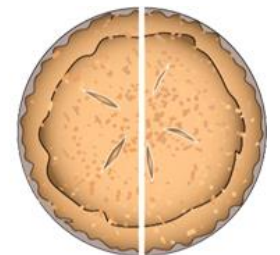
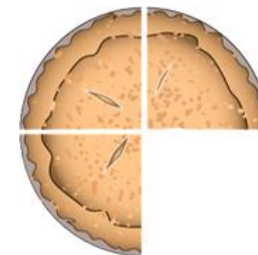
If possible please access week 3 of the online Maths lessons on White Rose Maths, which completes our learning about fractions, before moving on to measures.

## RE

Pentecost- Spread the Word.

1. Pentecost Day.

Look at the picture and read the scripture, based on Acts 2: 1-4. Discuss how the Holy Spirit has filled Jesus' friends with new life. They are not afraid anymore, they wanted to share their joy. The Holy Spirit is a helper and guide. **Think about how the people are all feeling and why. Compare this to last week's work on Ascension Day. Draw your own image of Pentecost Day.**

2. Passing on the Good News.

The Holy Spirit is with everyone. People can pray to the Holy Spirit whenever they or anyone else needs help. The Holy Spirit is the friend that Jesus promised. The Holy Spirit will help people all their lives so that they can join Jesus in Heaven when it is time for them to go there. Read and discuss the scripture based on Thessalonians.

## Science

'Plants.'

Carry out your own research or use the powerpoint to find out about the life cycle of plants.

Draw pictures/ create a poster to show how plants grow.

If you are able to, plant some seeds or a bean and watch how it changes and grows over the coming weeks. Keep a diary to show the changes.

## PE

Try to carry out at least 30 minutes exercise daily- this can be any activity you choose.



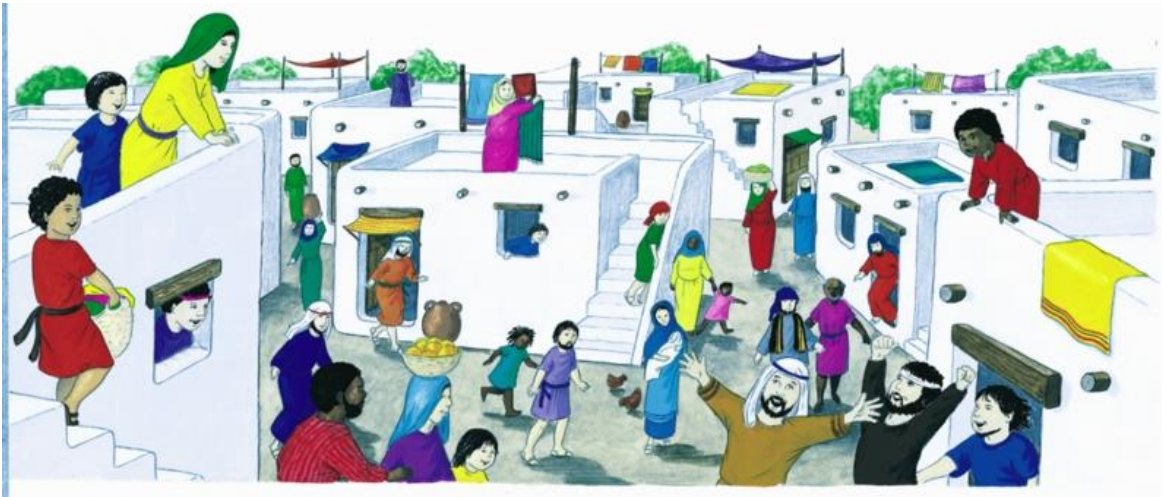
Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May marks the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of VE Day.

After Jesus had gone back to his Father, his friends stayed together with Mary, Jesus' Mother. Peter was there and James and John and all the others.

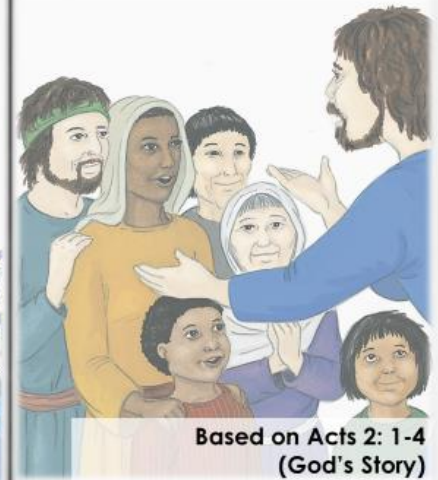
They missed Jesus very much. They felt weary and lost. They couldn't get up and get on with their lives. They didn't know what to do.

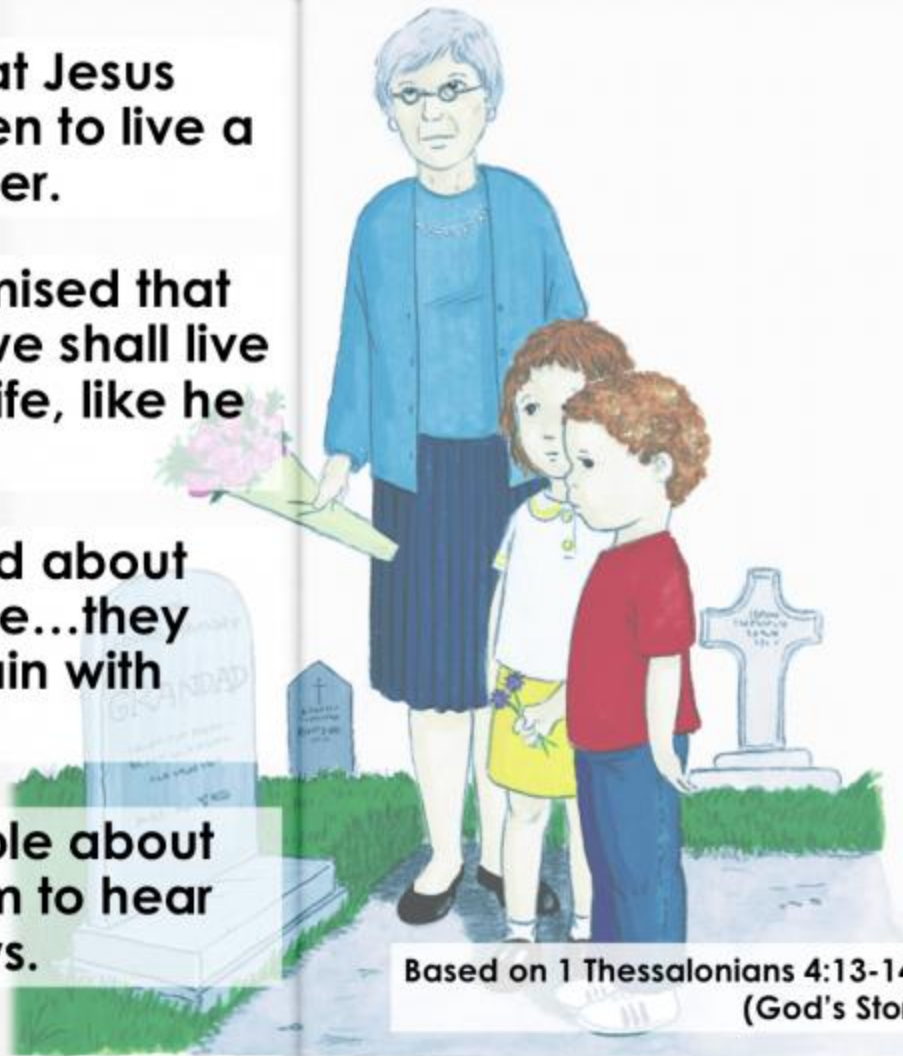
