<u>Maths</u>

This week we will continue learning about length and height.

We measure length and height using centimetres (cm) and metres (m). If you have a ruler and/or tape measure at home, have a look at the size of 1cm and 1m. How many cm are in 1m?

When you know how long 1cm and 1m is, have a go at some of the following tasks:

- Find some objects around your house and put them in order of length or height (vocabulary to use longer, shorter, longest, smallest, taller, tallest)
- If you have a ruler/ tape measure or similar, try to measure some of these objects using cm or m
- Look around your house- can you see/find things longer than 1m? What about shorter than 1m?
- Practise your adding skills by adding together the length/height of 2/3 objects
- Practise your subtraction skills by finding the difference between the length/height of two objects

Mo has used the ruler to measure the length of the car.




Mo says the car is 8 centimetres long. Do you agree? Explain your answer.

Teddy has a toy train and a toy plane. The train is 28 cm long. The plane is 16 cm longer. How long is the plane?

The toy train is double the length of a toy car. How long is the toy car? Amir has a metre stick.

He wants to measure the length of his classroom.

I can't measure the length of the classroom because my metre stick isn't long enough.



Explain to Amir how he could measure the length of his classroom.

Think about the following questions:


