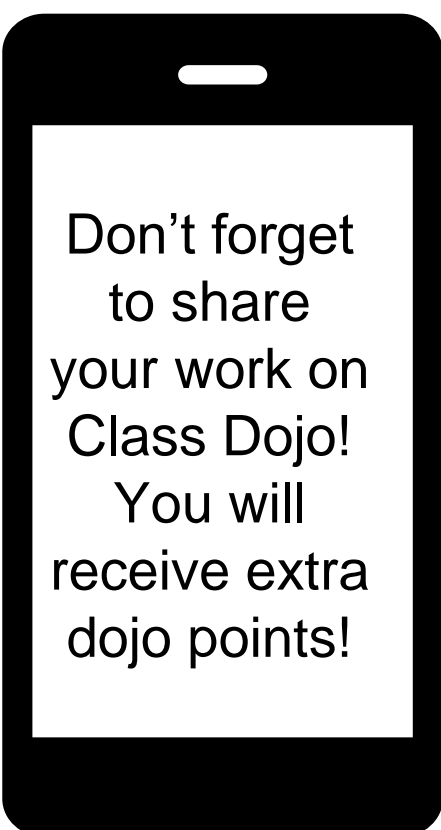
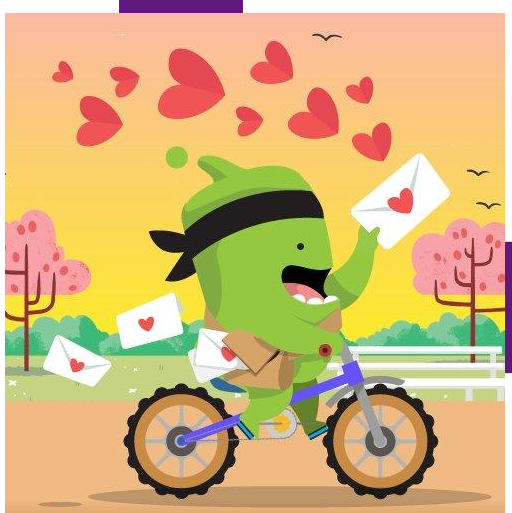
Next week's spellings are:
