This week, we are looking at spellings that belong to two more word families.


## 'press'

which is often connected to words that mean 'press'


### 'vent'

which is often connected to words that mean 'come'


How many words can you and your partner think of containing the root word 'press'? You have 3 minutes.




How many words can you and your partner think of containing the root word 'vent'? You have 3 minutes.


