


St Gregory's Catholic Academy Curriculum Newsletter Year 4

We will then progress to recapping punctuation from Year 3 and learning about sentence types for description. We will apply these skills in description writing and narrative writing. We will continue to practise our handwriting, in order to ensure a fluent, joined writing style.


Science

This term we will be learning about Living Things and their habitats. We will be learning how to use classification keys to classify living things in different ways, before learning about human impact on the environment (eq. Litter and deforestation). Our second topic this term will be electricity.



The Arts


Maths

This term we will begin by learning about place value. This will include understanding 4 digit numbers, rounding to the nearest 10 and 100 and comparing numbers.



We will then progress onto addition and subtraction involving 4 digit numbers. We will also be consolidating our knowledge of the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables, before progressing on to learning the 6 times tables.

History / Geography


