It shows that something belongs to one person or more than one person.

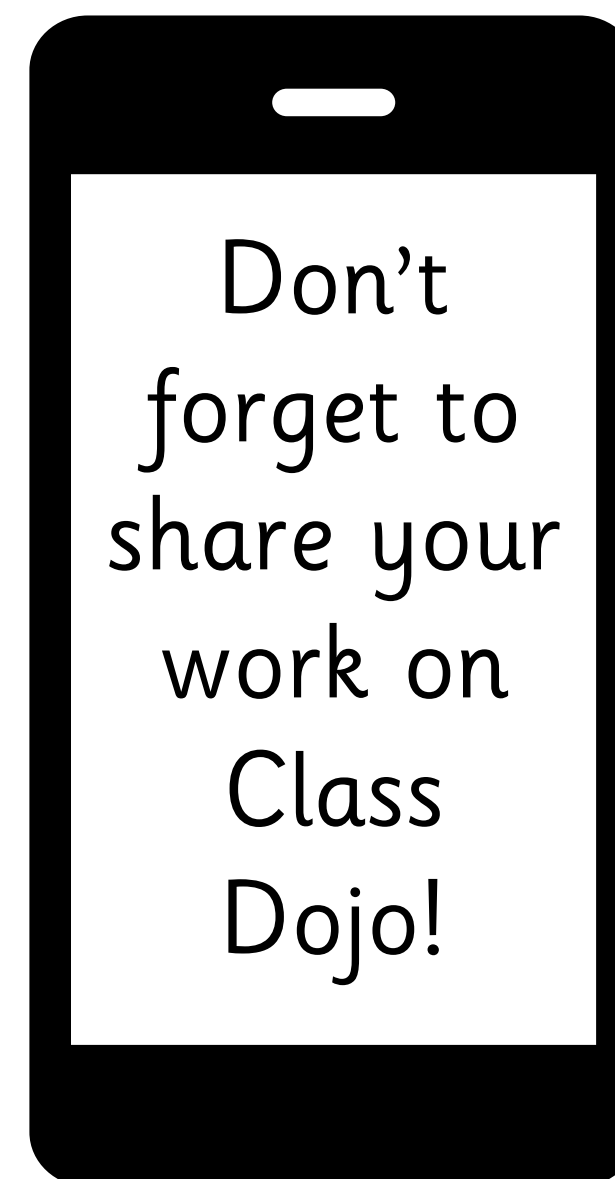
they^are There
