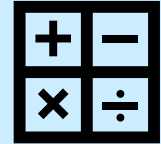


Year 5 Homework – Friday 25th September



Maths

Recap the learning we have looked at this week: rounding to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10000 by watching the rounding video on YouTube (Rounding Numbers Song).

You could also try rolling a dice to come up with some five and six digit numbers then ordering them from smallest to largest (ascending order) or largest to smallest (descending order).
