- After you have finished a book, try writing a summary (a short re-tell) in only 1 paragraph!
- Create a character profile for one of the main characters of your book.
- Before reading a book, use the front cover to record your predictions about what might happen.
- Every now and then, stop and think: what is happening? What are the characters feeling? How do I know?

Maths

Do some *imaginary shopping*! Give yourself a budget and explore online supermarkets. Add up your items as you go, and see if you can stay within budget.

Science

Then, use your knowledge to create a musical instrument!

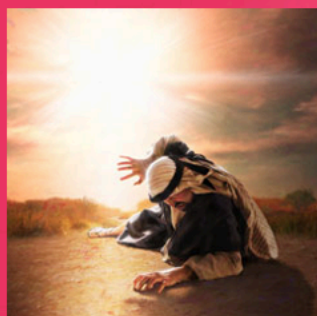
Also, why not investigate which material is the best for sound proofing?
