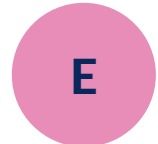

- Encourage and support my child's home learning by helping them to complete homework and read, ideally daily.
- Attend Learning Cafes and parents' evenings to discuss my child's progress and make an appointment to see my child's teacher to discuss any other issues that concern me.
