## Coronavirus Testing Guidance

Dear Parents / Carers

Please see the information below regarding which tests primary school children and adults should take if they have one of the three main symptoms of Coronavirus:

### *If you have coronavirus symptoms*

The most important symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If you have symptoms of COVID-19, **arrange to have a PCR test**. Stay at home while you are waiting for a home self-sampling kit, a test site appointment or a test result. Do not use the rapid lateral flow testing service as this is only for people without symptoms.

**Lateral flow tests are only to be used by people without symptoms** (as they may identify cases that are asymptomatic and would otherwise be missed). School cannot accept a negative lateral flow result if your child (or anyone living in their house) has symptoms of Coronavirus, we can only accept results from PCR testing. If you do a lateral flow test and the result is positive current guidance asks that you also have a PCR test to confirm the result.
